


We are now accepting nominations for "The 5th Kanazawa University International Award in commemoration of Daisetz T. Suzuki and Kitaro Nishida".

The International Award is established in honor of Daisetz T. Suzuki (1870-1966) and Kitaro Nishida (1870-1945), both of whom are associated with Kanazawa University, and is intended to honor researchers who have made outstanding international achievements in the fields of philosophy, thought, and religion. The purpose of this award is to promote the further development of research in these fields and to provide a significant academic stimulus to young researchers who will lead the next generation.

## Nomination Guidelines for the Fifth Kanazawa University International Award

1. Academic areas	Philosophy, thought and religion
2. Content of the award	Award certificate and award plaque, accompanied by prize money of five million yen
3. Number of winners	One
4. Eligible nominees	Scholars or researchers who have made internationally distinguished achievements in the realm of philosophy, thought or religion
5. Nomination period:	Wednesday, November, 15, 2023 – Tuesday, April, 30, 2024
<ul> <li>6. Schedule for selection and the award ceremony</li> <li>(1) Selection of award winner: Early September, 2024</li> <li>(2) Award ceremony : Tuesday, November, 19, 2024 [Note] The awardee should attend the award ceremony and deliver a memorial lecture.</li> </ul>
